This adorable huggy bib is perfect for keeping your little one clean and dry during mealtimes. It's made with soft, cozy yarn and features a cute reindeer applique. The bib is easy to crochet, and the pattern includes step-by-step instructions and images to help you along the way.

Materials

- Worsted weight yarn in two colors (main color and contrasting color)
- 4.0 mm crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Gauge

4 stitches and 4 rows = 1 inch in single crochet

Finished Size

Approximately 12 inches wide by 14 inches long

Abbreviations

* sc: single crochet * dc: double crochet * hdc: half double crochet * sl st: slip stitch * ch: chain * st(s): stitch(es)

Instructions

Main Bib

1. With main color, ch 30. 2. Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch across. (29 sc) 3. Ch 1, turn. 4. Sc in each sc across. (29 sc) 5. Repeat Rows 3-4 until the piece measures 12 inches long. 6. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Reindeer Applique

1. With contrasting color, ch 6. 2. Join with a sl st to form a ring. 3. Ch 1, 12 sc in the ring. (12 sc) 4. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Antlers

1. With contrasting color, ch 10. 2. Sl st to form a ring. 3. Ch 1, 5 sc in the ring. (5 sc) 4. Ch 2, turn. 5. Hdc in each sc across. (5 hdc) 6. Ch 2, turn. 7. Dc in each hdc across. (5 dc) 8. Ch 2, turn. 9. Hdc in each dc across. (5 hdc) 10. Ch 2, turn. 11. Sc in each hdc across. (5 sc) 12. Sl st to join. 13. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Nose

1. With contrasting color, ch 3. 2. Join with a sl st to form a ring. 3. Ch 1, 6 sc in the ring. (6 sc) 4. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Eyes

1. With contrasting color, ch 2. 2. Join with a sl st to form a ring. 3. Ch 1, 4 sc in the ring. (4 sc) 4. Fasten off and weave in ends. 5. Repeat for the other eye.

Assembly

1. Sew the reindeer applique to the center of the bib. 2. Sew the antlers to the top of the reindeer's head. 3. Sew the nose to the center of the reindeer's face. 4. Sew the eyes to either side of the nose.

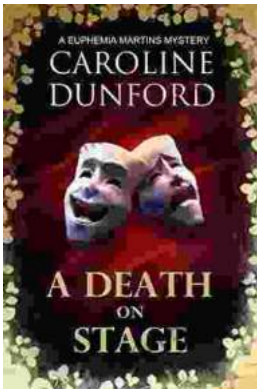

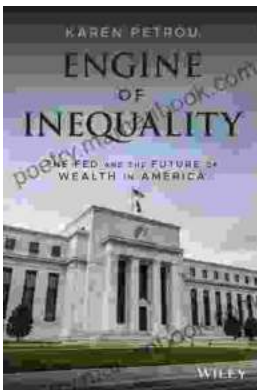
