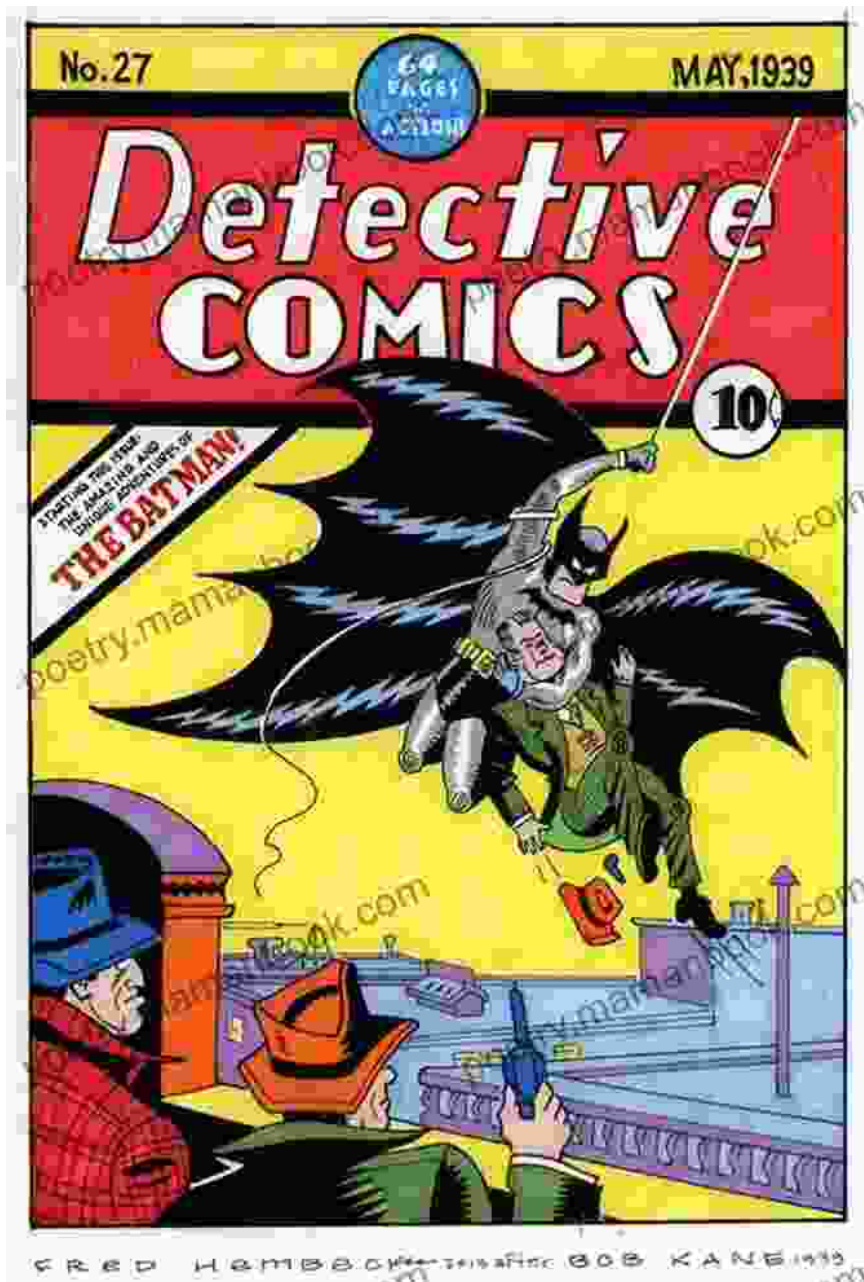
- 1937



Detective Comics #1 (March 1937)

The Batman television series premiered on ABC in 1966. The series starred Adam West as Batman and Burt Ward as Robin. The series ran for three seasons and 120 episodes, and is considered one of the most iconic television shows of all time.

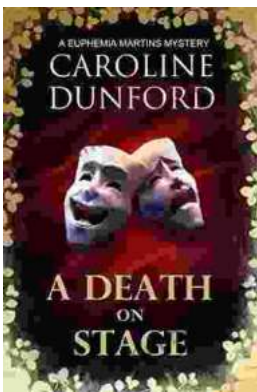

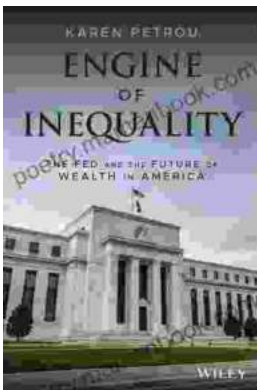
