

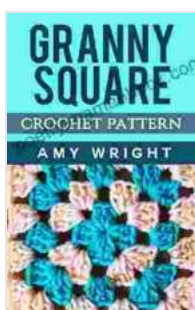

5. **Round 4:** Ch 1, (sc, ch 2, 3 sc in the ch-2 space, ch 2, sc) 4 times, sc in the next ch-2 space, (ch 2, 3 sc in the ch-2 space, ch 2, sc) 4 times, sc in the last ch-2 space. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 1.

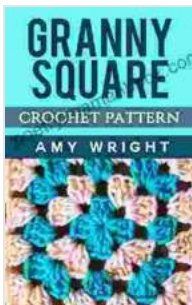

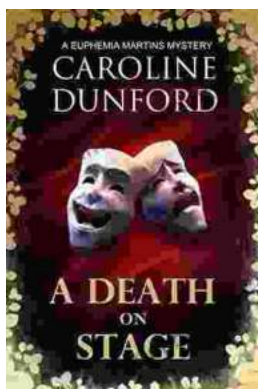

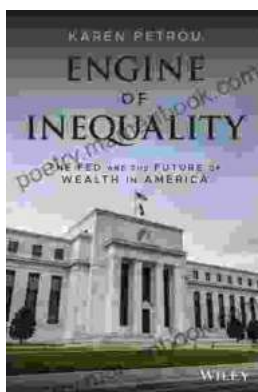
