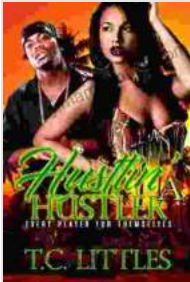

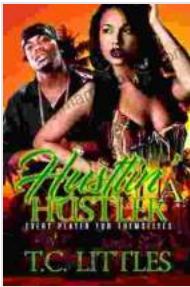

In this essay I shall be analysing the June 1978 cover of Hustler magazine (fig. 1), discussing feminism and the subjectification of women at the time, as well as the covers impact on 21st century pop culture. As well as this, I shall be looking at Hall's (1997) quote on representation, showing how an image can have multiple layers and meanings. The 1970's was a time where feminism was increasingly growing, not just in Britain but around the world. One key fact to mention of the decade is the 1979 prime minister election in which Margaret Thatcher one, making her the first female prime minister of Britain. This was a huge move forward for feminism at the time and was proof that women truly could do what men could do, helping to push an ever growing feminist movement. The cover could have been seen as a step back words by some feminist, looking at the strides women were making, then having a cover of a pornographic magazine still act like women are meat and are just there for one purpose, to sexually satisfy a man.

Hustler magazine, a pornographic publication, was set up in 1974 by Larry Flynt as a competitor to the likes of Playboy and Penthouse, who alienated the average working man with their layouts and unattainable models (pornography.com, Editors, 2015). The image is the cover of Hustler magazine for June 1978. It features a pair of women's legs, sticking out of a meat grinder in the middle, with minced meat coming out the other end onto a plate on the bottom left of the cover. The meat grinder is attached to a wooden board, possibly a tabletop. The magazine uses Futura 2B demibold font in blue, as well as a quote by Larry Flynt, founder of Flynt publications, the publishers of Hustler magazine, in black. There is also a giveaway in red, as well as the price of the publication in different currencies. 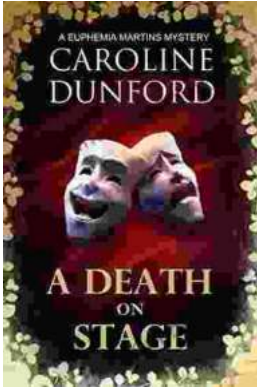

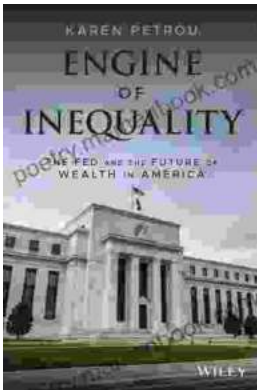
